



Richard W. King is being recognized for his Superior Bowling Ability.

King has been a member of the Butler County Bowling Association for 35 years and has been involved in organized bowling for 47 years. He has participated in 10-12 Butler County tournaments, being crowned champion in 2003, and 6-8 USBC tournaments.

The highest league average for King is 221. He has rolled two 800 series, with the highest being 816, and over forty 700 series. King has three 300 games, two 299 games and four games of 11 in a row.

King has been named Freeway Lanes Bowler of the Year three times. He also has a PSBA singles championship to his credit, recorded in 1994, with a 772 series. King won the Taylor Chair tournament in Monroeville in the 1980s and bowled as on the Regional Professional Tour from 1978-1984, with a fourth place as his best finish.

King lives in Gibsonia with his wife, Sally, and is employed as a salesman with Robinson Fans in Zelienople.
